The school will:

Ensure every child matters by:

- Providing a happy, caring and secure learning environment

Parents/Carers will be expected to:

- Uphold the school values at all times which are based around nature and sustainability
- Support children's learning at home, including reading at home at least 3 times a week and completing online homework through Google Classroom to save paper
- Be punctual in bringing children to school and collecting them at the end of the day and inform the school of a child's absence by telephone by 9.30am on each day of absence
- Attend parent's evenings and meetings, to discuss the child's progress
- Be ambitious for your child's education and work in partnership with the school
- Keep school informed of anything, however small, which may affect your child's learning
- Encourage a healthy lifestyle by walking, cycling or scooting to school, where possible
- Check their child's hair regularly for head lice and to keep long hair tied back
- Children to follow the school uniform policy every day
- Ensure children do not bring any personal items into school, including toys and cards
- Actively support the essential fundraising work of our Parent Teacher Association (PTA)
- Assist in upholding our high standards for behaviour and uniform
- Read all correspondence from the school, including the weekly newsletter
- Raise any grievances with the school when they arise using the complaints policy. It is never acceptable to raise grievances on social media

The children will:

- Be kind and helpful to others including online
- Play kindly and use the playground sensibly
- Help to keep the school clean and tidy by putting things back where they belong and look after school property
- Set good examples to others and act as a role model
