The first figure we discussed was Martin Luther King who fought for an end to segregation and for equal treatment for all. In one of his famous speeches he said, "I have a dream that my four little children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the colour of their skin but by their character". We also discussed a Native American Ponka Chief, Standing Bear, who in 1879 challenged the American justice system to treat Native Americans as equal, he said in court "That hand is not the colour of yours, but if I prick it, the blood will flow, and I shall feel pain. The blood is of the same colour as yours. God made me, and I am a Man." We agreed that our school was a place where all are valued equally but that even in today's advanced world there are often people still treated differently because of their characteristics which is something we should all be aware of and challenge.


